## *Case Studies: What Would You Do?*

### **Case Study# 1** **Serodiscordant Heterosexual Couple**

- Jaclyn, a 24 year old college student is HIV-uninfected
- This is her first visit with you
- She has been in a monogamous relation with Frank, a high school teacher for the past 4 years
- Jaclyn is sexually active (oral, vaginal and anal sex) 2-3 times/week and seldom uses condoms
- Her exam is normal, STI screen is negative
- Last month, Frank told Jaclyn that he found out that he was HIV+
- His HIV VL is 32,500
- They plan to marry in 4 months when she graduates



### **Case Study# 2** **Adolescent Bisexual Male**

- You are provider in a Primary Care Clinic
- Rod is an 19 year old bisexual Hispanic male
- He is home from College for the summer break
- Rod is entering his sophomore year
- All of Rod's family are your patients
- Rod presents to your office today requesting PrEP
